Rules

- All Exhibitors must be a member by June 2, 2008 of the Michigan Junior Shorthorn Association who are between the **ages of 9 and 21 as of January 1st, 2008**. All cattle must be **solely owned by the exhibitor**.
- Cattle may arrive from 7am to 9am.
- Exhibitors must clean their stalls or will be charged a clean-up fee.
- TB Test Requirements: Bovine TB is bacterial disease of cattle that is of concern to all cattle producers in Michigan. All cattle participating in the 2007 Michigan Jr Shorthorn Association State Show must have an RFID tag. Neither an official USD Alphanumeric metal ear tag nor an official breed registry tattoo will be accepted in place of an RFID tag. In addition, all cattle regardless of age must meet one of the following requirements with respect to TB testing:
 - For cattle in the Modified Accredited Zone: (Alcona Alpena, Antrim, Charlevoix, Emmett, Cheboygan, Crawford, Iosco, Ogemaw, Otsego, Oscoda, Montmorency, Otsego, and Presque Isle counties) Must provide a movement permit and be identified with an RFID tag issued by MDA and have a whole herd test within the past 12 months. In addition, if the whole herd test was conducted greater than 60 days prior to the show, must provide proof that the individual animal was TB tested with negative results within 60 days prior to this show. No individual test is required if originating from an accredited TB free herd.
 - For cattle in the Modified Accredited Advanced Zone: (All counties in the Lower Peninsula outside of the Modified Accredited Zone) - No TB testing is required
 - For cattle in the TB Free Zone (the Upper Peninsula) – NO TB testing is required.
- All cattle must be dehorned if horn length is greater than two inches.
- Cattle infected with a communicable disease may not be brought to the show. To meet the health standards required to show, animals need to be free of illness including but not limited to:
 - Clinical signs of respiratory disease (watery eyes, nasal discharge, elevated temperature, excessive slobbering)
 - Active ringworm and/or warts
 - Identifiable external parasites
 - Evidence of surgical, conformation or any other unethical alterations will result in the animal and exhibitor being disqualified from competition.
