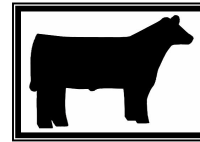

General Rules for Show:

1. All cattle must meet Wisconsin Health Requirements.
2. The WJSA, WSA, and the Valley Beef Association members or volunteers are not responsible or liable for any injury or loss during any part of the show. All contestants must supply the show committee with a signed release statement before being allowed to participate. (This release statement is provided on the entry form.)
3. All cattle must be under the control of the exhibitor at all times. If the animal causes danger, it will be removed from the show.
4. Participants must be Wisconsin Junior Simmental Association members to show. \$10.00 yearly dues may be sent with the entry form.
5. Participants must be nine years olds prior to January 1, 2008 and must not have reached their 22nd birthday prior to January 1, 2008.
6. Participants 8 years and under who have not reached their 9th birthday prior to January 1, 2008 are eligible for Pee-Wee Showmanship.
7. **No paint or artificial coloring will be allowed and will be enforced by the "White Towel" Rule.**
8. **Bedding is NOT provided.** Stalls must be cleaned before leaving.
9. The show is open to purebred and percentage steers, purebred and percentage heifers and purebred and percentage cow/calf pairs.
10. All weaned calves must have registration papers.

Steer Show:

1. All steers must be registered with the American Simmental Association (ASA) as half-blood or greater.
2. All steers are to be born after January 1, 2007 and be no younger than January 1, 2008.
3. Classes will be divided upon check-in.

Purebred Cow/Calf Show:

1. Purebred cows must be registered with the ASA as purebred Simmental.
2. Calf at side must be born on or after January 1, 2008.
3. Classes will be divided upon entry.

Percentage Cow/Calf Show:

1. Percentage cows must be registered with the ASA as ½ to ¾ blood Simmental.
2. Calf at side must be born on or after January 1, 2008.
3. Classes will be divided upon entry.

Purebred Heifer Show:

1. Purebred heifers must have been born after August 31, 2006, and be registered with the ASA as purebred Simmental.
2. Classes will be divided upon entry.

Percentage Show:

1. Percentage heifers must have been born after August 31, 2006, and must be registered with the ASA as ½ to ¾ blood Simmental.
2. Classes will be divided upon entry.
